WHAT TO BRING

BRING:

- ONE suitcase & ONE backpack only!!!
 - Clothes for five days
 - Daily—shorts for sports camp & work projects
 - Jacket & pants for cold weather
 - Toiletries

 - Towel, washcloth

LEAVE:

CELL PHONES:
