ATTITUDE OF GRATITUDE

1 Thessalonians 5:18 "Give thanks IN ALL CIRCUMSTANCES, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

Giving thanks is the expression of my confident trust that God is too wise to make any mistakes & too loving to be unkind in His dealing with me. How can we develop an "attitude of gratitude?"


