# IV. The Poetical Books

- |                 |  |

| The Book of Job | - Blessing through Suffering, Hunted       |
| The Psalms      | - Praise and Prayer                        |
| The Proverbs    | - Prudence through Precept                 |
| Ecclesiastes    | - Solomon's spiritual trek (David to Saul) |
| Song of Solomon | - Soul Purpose (not the church)            |

# V. Hebrew Poetry - Parallelism versus meter & rhyme & metaphor

- 2 or 3 lines, sometimes forming a stanza and some stanzas a song
- Not just redundancy
- Amplify or contrast
- In all prophets Prose and Poetry
- Terse, Nahum 3:1-4.

# VI. Reiterate

- Psalm 92:12-15 - reiterate for emphasis
- Proverbs 6:2-5 - poetry for warning emphasis
- Psalm 46:1 - theological statement and application of statement
- Psalm 19:7-8 - two same theological statements  
two different applications (double parallel)
- Psalm 1 - triple and progression
